

Lake Pointe Elementary Procedures ***Please Note Changes***

“Safety of our Children Comes First”

These changes are being implemented to create an orderly and safe exit from our campus and to minimize the possibility of a child being injured in an accident.



Buses

Morning: 7:20 - 7:40 a.m.

1. Bus Riders → Dropped off back of school → Enter side door in first floor of first grade wing → Go to gym
- *** 2. Car Riders → Dropped off front of school and back of school depending on where you live and the direction you are driving from → Enter door by gym or first grade wing → Go to gym
If a bus is unloading...all traffic laws apply. (No passing of the bus. Cars must stop.)
3. Walkers with Parent → Use sidewalk → Enter door by gym or first grade wing → Go to gym
4. Bicycle Riders with Parent → Use sidewalk to back of school →
5. Parent Parking Car and escorting child → Park in upper back parking lot → Use sidewalk
→ Enter door by gym or first grade wing
6. Walkers and Bicycle Riders Unescorted by Parent → Enter side door in first floor of first grade wing → Go to gym

Afternoon: 2:45 – 3:00 p.m.

- ***1. Bus Riders → Leave through middle back door → Load buses in back parking lot near middle back door. Buses depart at 2:50 p.m.
2. Car Riders → Children go to gym → Parent uses front drive through → Child is called from gym or sidewalk and meets parent at car in front of school
3. Escorted Walkers/ bikers with Parent / Parking car → Park in upper back parking area designated for visitors → Walk down steps and wait at end doors of first grade wing for release of your student → Students go to end doors of first grade wing and are released by staff to parent
- ***4. Unescorted Walkers and Bicycle Riders → Teacher takes student to side doors of kinder wing → Siblings meet → Exit school through front kinder wing doors → Walk out to front sidewalk to street sidewalk. Unescorted bicycle riders will walk down sidewalk on street and come up sidewalk by small playscape to their bikes.

Please encourage your children/family to use designated crosswalks when crossing the street.
