Friends Shine Online is an online program for adults with special needs who wish to remain connected with friends & engage in the world around them. **Friends Shine Online** Facilitated by professional staff, we offer structured activities that nurture mind/body & promote personal interaction that everyone needs, in a wholesome, friendly environment. Friends Shine Online is a happy, positive, online community for participants with disabilities 18 years of age & older. Giomara Cintron is Long-Term Services and Support Specialist covering 30 counties here in Region 7, specializing in targeted outreach to STAR Kids transitioning to STAR+PLUS. Gio represents Texas Health Steps Outreach & Informing, Texas STAR, STAR+PLUS, STAR Kids programs serving Medicaid children & Maximus -Giomara Cintron families. We educate clients on how to use their Texas Health Steps Medicaid benefits, assist on choosing a medical or dental health plan & a Primary Care Physician & do plan changes if necessary. Strategic Financial Group Strategic Financial Group provides financial planning solutions for parents with Special Needs Children. E4Texas is a post-secondary opportunity for people with or without a disability, who are over the age of 18, who have a high school diploma, & are UT Austin - E4 Texas employment-focused. The E4Texas 3-semester experience combines classroom instruction with practical career building experiences, independent living skills, & self-determination. VELA is an Austin-based nonprofit that supports and empowers parents of children with disabilities through skills-building courses, case management, monthly **VELA** support groups and community building events. 


