Parents or guardians should **register** their child at the elementary school within the attendance zone associated with his/her residence.

Children who meet all registration and eligibility requirements and reside in:

- Bee Cave and Lake Pointe elementary attendance zones will attend Prekindergarten at **Lake Pointe Elementary**.
- Lake Travis and Lakeway elementary attendance zones will attend Prekindergarten at **Lake Travis Elementary**.
- Serene Hills, West Cypress Hills, and Rough Hollow elementary attendance zones will attend Prekindergarten at **Serene Hills Elementary**.
- Lake Travis ISD children who meet all registration and eligibility requirements and receive bilingual services will attend Prekindergarten at **Lake Travis Elementary**.

Parents or guardians will be **required to provide proof of eligibility** BEFORE the start of school in August in order for the child to enter the Prekindergarten program. All pre-kindergarten placements are dependent upon available space in PK

Pre-Kindergarten program placement is dependent upon space at each campus. To be eligible for Prekindergarten, a child must live in the District, be 4 years of age on or before September 1, 2021, AND meet one of the following:

1. Be unable to speak and comprehend the English language; or
2. Be educationally disadvantaged, which means a student eligible to participate in the national free or reduced-price lunch program; or
3. Be homeless, as defined by 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 1143a, regardless of the residence of the child, of either parent of the child, or of the child's guardian or other person having lawful control of the child; or
4. Be the child of an active duty member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who is ordered to active duty by proper authority; or
5. Be the child of a member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who was injured or killed while serving on active duty; or
6. Be in, or have been in, the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) following an adversary hearing held as provided by Section 262.201, Family Code; or
7. Be the child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas Award as a peace officer (3106.002), firefighter (3106.003), or emergency medical first responder (3106.004).

To pre-register a child, parents or guardians must present the following documents:

- ✓ Complete the online enrollment (links on the website will be posted on March 24th).
- ✓ Submit needed documents (electronically when possible) to the campus registrar.
- ✓ Completed, printed and signed New Student Enrollment Packet
- ✓ Certified copy of birth certificate*
- ✓ Proof of residency (i.e., lease agreement, sales contract, closing documents, property tax statement, or property deed **and** a current utility bill – water, electricity or gas – with matching address.)
- ✓ Immunization records (see Immunization Requirements [here](#))
- ✓ Social Security Card (preferred, but optional)
- ✓ Photo ID of parent/guardian enrolling child

**If your child was born in Texas, you may obtain a certified copy of the birth certificate from the Texas Health Department or the Austin Office of Vital Records. For instructions on how to order a certificate, visit www.austintexas.gov/birthcertificates.*
