Goals

Goal 1: Student Achievement:

Lake Travis High School will increase academic achievement for all learners while closing the gap between student populations in pursuit of "Masters" performance level using research-based best practices.

Performance Objective 1: 75% of all students will meet the final Level II standard on STAAR/EOC (State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness/End of Course).

Performance Objective 2: 25% increase in the percent of students reaching Advanced Achievement Level III on STAAR/EOC as compared to previous year student performance.

Performance Objective 3: Increase the Level III performance of economically disadvantaged students by 20% compared to previous year performance.

Goal 2: Community Investment and Support:

Lake Travis High School will welcome, inform and engage students, parents, and the community regarding the educational priorities, processes, initiatives, and challenges of the District/Campus.

Performance Objective 1: LTHS will utilize existing communication platforms to provide parents opportunities to become involved at LTHS.

Performance Objective 2: Increase the formal and informal ways for parents to become involved at LTHS.

Performance Objective 3: Create a mentoring program that specifically meets the needs of our at-risk student groups.

Goal 3: Curriculum & Instruction:

Lake Travis High School will develop, implement, assess, and support full implementation of the learner-centric model which includes a high quality, vertically aligned framework that supports planning, instruction, learning environment and professional practices and responsibilities.

Performance Objective 1: All content academic teams will develop a functioning PLC.

Performance Objective 2: 100% of teachers will maintain accurate and standardized web presence with Schoology.

Performance Objective 3: Each academic team will have a vertical alignment track that reflects the skills learned for each academic discipline.

Goal 4: School Environment: (Chapter 37 / Discipline - Law and Order):

Lake Travis High School will provide an educational environment that reflects a commitment to student social and emotional wellness, safety, security, orderliness, service, integrity and high standards of citizenship among students, staff, community, and visitors.

Performance Objective 1: Students will utilize LTHS Tip Line to reduce vandalism, bullying, etc.

Performance Objective 2: All staff will comply with campus safety measures.

Performance Objective 3: 65% of all students will be involved in at least one extracurricular activity sponsored by LTHS.

Performance Objective 4: Increase the response and perception to the Leader4Life Program

Performance Objective 5: Decrease the number of discretionary placements to DAEP by 25%.

Performance Objective 6: Support efforts to increase the awareness and prevention of bullying, harassment, and dating violence through staff development, student training, and by implementation of the district's procedures regarding bullying, harassment, and dating violence.

Goal 5: College and Career Readiness (P-16):

Lake Travis High School will design programming that equips all learners in developing their voice, focusing on a growth mindset, resiliency, and grit to become socially, emotionally, college, career, and life ready.

Performance Objective 1: Greater than 95% completion rates for all students (4-year longitudinal) with at least 95% in each student population.

Performance Objective 2: Foundations High School Program with Endorsement (Goal: 95%)

Performance Objective 3: AP results will have 85% of examinees meeting = 3+ on exam score criterion

Performance Objective 4: 90% of all students enrolled in AP classes will take the AP exam.

Performance Objective 5: 95% of LTHS students will have met the Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Higher Education Readiness.

Performance Objective 6: Greater than 60% of students who score at or above the national average on College Admissions Tests.

Performance Objective 7: Increase enrollment in courses that assist students in developing the knowledge, skills, and competencies for a broad range of career opportunities (including Tech Prep) by 10%.

Performance Objective 8: 80% of students enrolled in dual credit will earn credit.

Goal 6: Highest Quality Staff:

Lake Travis High School will recruit, hire, develop, and retain the highest quality faculty and staff.

Performance Objective 1: 100% of new teachers will be paired with a mentor to support their first year at our campus and participate in a formal, monthly new teacher academy.

Performance Objective 2: At least 50% of this staff development for teachers will be led by fellow teachers.

Performance Objective 3: New recruiting procedures are developed for finding future LTHS teachers.
